With thankfulness to God the following offerings were received for the month of July. General Fund \$17,665.45, Benevolent Fund \$1,047.41, Building Fund \$6,230.50, Trinity Christian High School \$1,585.40, Hull Protestant Reformed Christian School \$5,844.25, High School Tuition Assistance \$601.15, Foreign Missions \$246.75, Foreign Student Aid Fund \$169.50

The Council will be making nominations for the office of elder and deacon at the September 4 meeting. The Council's intent with the no smoking policy was to limit the unhealthy example upon our young people and children. The modified decision better accomplishes this purpose.
