FROM THE COUNCIL

After a week of self-examination, confessing members in good standing are called and privileged to partake of the sacrament of the Lord's Supper this morning. Our participation in the Lord's Supper is a witness that we repent of our sins, believe that Jesus Christ is our righteousness, and desire to live in godliness. As this heavenly food can be taken

to one's judgment (I Cor. 11:28-30) and as the receiving of this food as a congregational body is a confession of doctrinal oneness (Acts 2:42), the elders supervise the partaking of the sacrament. If you are visiting from another PRC congregation, please contact the elders before communing. Visitors from other denominations must appear to make their request at the consistory meeting prior to communion. If we cannot administer the sacrament to you, we are not judging whether or not you are a child of God; we are simply recognizing the reality that there is not at this time doctrinal agreement between our respective church bodies. Please respect our desire to be faithful to God's Word in this matter.

The consistory has approved the request of Mr. Titus Mahtani to partake of the Lord's Supper with us. Titus is a member at our Holland PRC and is attending by us while he is at Dordt College.

Due to the meeting of Classis this week, there will be a pulpit exchange with Hull this evening.

At the meeting of Classis West this week, Pastor-elect Erik Guichelaar sustained his classical examination. We give thanks to God for adding another minister into our denomination of churches and pray God's Blessing upon the brother as he takes up his calling in Randolph PRC.

Our pastor has classical appointment to Doon next Sunday October 20. An elder will lead the morning service, and Rev. Lanning will lead our evening service **at 2pm**.
