"Synod Notice: The pre-synodical service will be held on Monday evening, June 12, at 7:00P.M., in Hudsonville Protestant Reformed Church. Rev. G. Eriks, president of Synod 2016, will preach the sermon. Synod convenes Tuesday morning at 8:00 in Hudsonville PRC.

Synod is scheduled to examine seven senior seminarians with a view to declaring them eligible for a call.
