FROM THE COUNCIL

After a week of self-examination, confessing members in good standing are called and privileged to partake of the sacrament of the Lord's Supper this morning. Our participation in the Lord's Supper is a witness that we repent of our sins, believe that Jesus Christ is our righteousness, and desire to live in godliness. As this heavenly food can be taken to one's judgment (I Cor. 11:28-30) and as the receiving of this food as a congregational body is a confession of doctrinal oneness (Acts 2:42), the elders supervise the partaking of the sacrament. If you are visiting from another PRC congregation, please contact the elders before communing. Visitors from other denominations must appear to make their request at the consistory meeting prior to communion. If we

cannot administer the sacrament to you, we are not judging whether or not you are a child of God; we are simply recognizing the reality that there is not at this time doctrinal agreement between our respective church bodies. Please respect our desire to be faithful to God's Word in this matter.

Steve and Patricia Hilt have asked for and received permission to partake of the Lord's Supper with us. Steve and Patricia intend to join our congregation. We welcome them with us to the table of the Lord.

Due to the possibility of severe weather today the council has moved the congregational meeting at which will we vote to call a pastor, to after the morning worship service. The men on the trio are Candidate David Norman, Rev. Jonathan Mahtani, and Rev. Brian Huizinga.
