The consistory voted to respond positively that the psalter revision should continue. While the consistory approved the continuation of this work based on the survey of Calvary's members, a summary of the concerns expressed on the survey by Calvary's members was also

included in the consistory's response to the Psalter Revision Committee.

The consistory has approved the transfer of membership of Rev. Cory Griess, his wife Lael and 6 baptized children to First Protestant Reformed Church of Grand Rapids, Michigan.
