Grandville PRC announces a trio for minister-on-loan to CERC in Singapore of Rev. G. Eriks (Hudsonville, MI), Rev. S. Key (Loveland, CO), and Rev. R. Kleyn (Spokane, WA).

The continuation of the May meeting of Classis East took place this past Wednesday at Faith PRC. The four remaining protests were now found to be no longer legally before Classis in light of Synod 2018. Grandville PRC requested and received pulpit supply for their evening services due to the emeritation of Rev. Koole. Rev. H. Bleyenbergh was appointed to be the Moderator for Grandville PRC. The expenses for this continuation meeting of Classis were \$481.35

Announcement from First PRC Grand Rapids--The Lord Willing, Prof. Cammenga, Rev. Rodney Kleyn, and Rev. Cory Griess will be traveling to Mexico City beginning July 24 to give speeches and make contact with a group of Presbyterian churches and church leaders there during the span of two weeks. There are two denominations of Presbyterian churches they will be meeting with, along with the professors and students of John Calvin University. Doner Bartolon, who is from Mexico and who intends to start seminary training in our seminary soon the Lord Willing, is the means by which God has allowed for this contact. Doner was born and raised in the Reformed faith in Mexico and has since become convicted of Protestant Reformed doctrine. First PRC is sponsoring the trip as an investigative endeavor.

The Lord Willing, in addition to preaching two Sundays, there will be five different conferences held on subjects such as the covenant, Calvinism, the history and doctrines of the PRC, and sexual ethics (youth conference). Please remember this trip and the work in your prayers.
