## FROM THE COUNCIL

The consistory will meet Monday evening after the Trinity concert at church at around 8:30 p.m. At the congregational meeting this past week Mr. Marv Van Den Top and Mr. Evert Van Maanen were elected to 3 year terms as elder and Mr. Nathan Van Maanen to a 3 year term as deacon. These men are presented to the congregation for approbation with a view to their installation into office on January 6 during the morning service, Lord willing. The proposed general fund budget was approved for 2019 of \$60 per week per family and the building fund budget remains for 2019 at \$100 per family per month.
