*"So then it is not of him that willeth, nor of him that runneth, but of God that sheweth mercy." (Rom. 9:16) Do not misunderstand as though the apostle says here that running and willing are unimportant for those who are saved. ...All he is saying is that that willing and running are not the source of salvation. There is a place for running. There is a place for choosing. An important place, a necessary place in the life of every saved child of God and in the life of the church. ...Is there someone here who is a member of the congregation, who professes to be saved by God's mercy, who is not choosing God and Christ and the good law of God for his life? Is*

*there someone here who is not running, running hard in all kinds of works (good works)? What is the matter with you? Repent! If there is someone who persists in that way, what that means is God has never showed mercy to him at all. When He shows His mercy to us, He works in us to will and to run. But that running and that willing are not our contribution to salvation, but themselves the mercy of God saving us." D. Engelsma*

*"The regeneration of the godly is, indeed, nothing else than the formation anew of the image of God in them. There is, no doubt, a far more rich and powerful manifestation of divine grace in this second creation than in the first; but our highest perfection is uniformly represented in Scripture consisting in our conformity and resemblance to God. Adam lost the image which he had originally received, and therefore it becomes necessary that it shall be restored to us by Christ. The design contemplated by regeneration is to recall us from our wanderings to that end for which we were created" John Calvin.*
