## FROM THE COUNCIL

The sermon this evening is preparatory with a view to the administration of the Lord's Supper next Sunday morning, July 14, Lord willing.

The council will meet on Monday, July 8, at 7 PM.

The consistory informs the congregation that in an effort to more closely follow Church Order Article 62, the entire Form for the Administration of the Lord's Supper will be read on the morning of the administration of the sacrament. Art. 62 states in part: "and that at the conclusion of the sermon and the usual prayers the form for the administration of the Lord's Supper, together with the prayer for that purpose, shall be read." The first part of the form will still be read during the preparatory service as has been our practice.

The consistory approved requests from Mr. and Mrs. Harrison Van Maanen for the baptism of their son, Hendrick Alan, and from Mr. and Mrs. Tayler Hoekstra for the baptism of their daughter, Savanna Rose. The sacrament will be administered during the morning service on July 21, Lord willing.
