Will you join the Reformed Witness Hour on Sunday Sept.1 in marking our 4000th broadcast? Since going on the air October 12, 1941, the RWH has, by the grace of God, continued to broadcast each Lord's Day the doctrines of sovereign, particular grace, so that on Sept.1 we will reach program number 4000. This very special broadcast will feature Rev. H. Hoeksema, our first radio pastor, preaching the sermon titled "Whosoever Will May Come". His sermon, first used on the radio program in October 1944, was originally recorded on a glass record but was recently preserved and converted into MP3 format. We are rebroadcasting "Whosoever Will May Come" for today's radio and internet audience as a powerful reminder of God's faithfulness through these 4000 RWH programs.
